MEET ROXANNE  
WAG 'N WALK'S 2010 MASCOT



**R**oxanne was only five weeks old when her owner brought her to the Martinez shelter to be euthanized. The owner indicated that she was sick and he didn't want to take care of her. Since Norcal Golden Retriever Rescue works closely with all of our local shelters, NGRR's county coordinator was notified.

Roxanne was rushed from the shelter to Bishop Ranch Veterinary Center in San Ramon. She was diagnosed with the deadly disease parvo. She weighed only four pounds, and had a zero white blood count. The doctors that cared for her estimated that she had only a 20 percent chance to live.

Roxanne stayed at the hospital for three days, receiving treatments 24 hours a day by a caring and professional team of doctors and assistants. One of the assistants that saved Roxanne's life was a Golden Retriever named Kelp. Kelp is a seven year old Golden who supplied two life saving blood transfusions to Roxanne.



After being released from the hospital, Roxanne went to live with a foster family while she recuperated. Of course, the fosters fell in love with her and after nursing her through her recovery, they adopted her. Her forever Mom, Sonya indicated, "Roxanne is a source of joy and makes every day a special event. None of this would have been possible without Norcal Golden Retriever Rescue and all of the people who kindly donate their money and time."

Much thanks goes to the staff at Bishop Ranch Veterinary Center and the dog lovers across the country that make donations. Thankfully, NGRR was able to pay for Roxanne's medical treatment.

Roxanne has fully recovered, graduated from Puppy School and is enjoying her first summer with her big brother Rusty, who is teaching her how to swim.
